Abu Dhabi, the capital of the United Arab Emirates*, is a modern city with a population of about 1.8 million people. The expanding economy and rising population have brought great (1) **benefits** to Abu Dhabi, but with them have come a major problem: traffic jams. Abu Dhabi, like many cities in the United Arab Emirates, suffers from traffic jams. The average commuting time of 45 minutes is fairly high.

One answer to the traffic problem is Masdar City. Masdar is a new city of 6 km² being built outside of Abu Dhabi. The city combines traditional Arabic architecture with energy efficiency. For example, Masdar gets all of its electricity from solar power. There is a wall around the city to keep out the hot desert wind and the streets are narrow, to provide (A) from the sun and allow wind to pass through. As a result, the city is about 10 °C cooler than in Abu Dhabi.

There are few traffic problems in Masdar because people are encouraged to use public transportation. Rail systems run through the center of the town and (B) Masdar to Abu Dhabi and the airport. A unique transport system called Personal Rapid Transit (PRT) was also planned and partially built. The original plan was to have 3,000 solar-powered, driverless vehicles which could carry passengers to about 100 stations all around the city. The vehicles would also be used to transport commuters from stations outside the city, where they would leave their own cars, to their destinations in the city. (C), only 13 PRTs are in operation today, because of high costs. As a result, environmentally friendly cars are now allowed. Today, those 13 PRTs are used to carry passengers in and out of the city center and Masdar residents can use clean-energy electric cars and buses to travel around the city.

Masdar City was originally (2) **projected** to cost around \$24 billion, but the global financial crisis of 2008–2009 reduced the amount of money which was available for the project. A few people worried that Masdar could become a 'green ghost town'—a place in which nobody would want to live. Yet today, construction is continuing, and Masdar City is expected to be completed sometime before 2030. When it is finally finished, there could be as many as 50,000 residents and 40,000 daily commuters. As work on the city continues and international businesses such as Siemens* choose to locate offices there, city planners are confident that Masdar's green solutions to both traffic and environmental problems will be more than the financial cost of building the city.

If Chelsea McClammer hadn't left her house that day, she might never have been in the accident that put her in a wheelchair. However, she also might not have become a world-class athlete. With support from family, friends, and some engineering, Chelsea is now a two-time champion at the international Paralympics for people with disabilities. She (A) in track and field events, and has taken home silver and bronze medals. The word 'never' isn't in her vocabulary.

If Roy Tuscany hadn't landed wrong on a ski jump, he might not have broken his spine* and lost mobility from the waist down. However, like McClammer, Tuscany is not the kind of person who says "I wish I could ...". In fact, he does several sports, including skiing, biking, and surfing, all with the help of specialized equipment designed by inspired engineers.

In today's technologically advanced world, athletes like McClammer and Tuscany benefit from a growing selection of equipment that makes sports more accessible to injured athletes. Sometimes equipment for regular athletes is (1) adapted, and sometimes new equipment is created for specific types of disability. McClammer uses a racing wheelchair that borrows ideas from both bicycles and aircraft design to get top speeds. She has teammates who run even though they don't have feet. Instead, they use special devices called blades that are attached to their knees. These athletes can race at speeds that match the fastest runners in the Olympics.

Many of these athletes also work to make sports more accessible to others. Tuscany has started a surfing camp called *High Five* that provides money and (B) for people with injuries and disabilities. A company in California makes special boards for each surfer. The athletes have a place to sit, and their legs are tied down. Then the surfer uses a special paddle* to move through the waves. Tuscany hopes that other people can learn that surfing is possible, even if you can't walk (C).

Assistive* technology is reaching a new level for sports, but also for daily life. The Cybathlon is a competition that allows inventors to show the world their prototypes* for new products. This international competition (2) takes place in Switzerland every year. The athletes are called pilots because they control the technology. In one event, competitors wear equipment that wraps around their legs and helps them walk. In another event, people with artificial hands hang up clothes or make a sandwich. Being able to do these tasks may not seem like a sport, but the event introduces technology that can increase independence and mobility, and potentially transform human lives.
