The Dhammachai Tipiṭaka Project, Thailand, is now working on producing a new critical edition of the Pāli canon based on palmleaf manuscripts of five traditions: Burmese/Mon, Sinhalese, Khom and Tham. In this talk, focusing on the Subhasutta, I will show the nature of our work on editing Pāli text from numerous manuscripts how we put all materials together on our platform, how we deal with various readings from those materials, what issues we found in the course of editing the text, etc.
